Additionally, they will develop a final poster and/or oral presentation for a fun end of camp research symposium with awards presented in several categories.

#### **Step into STEM (June 24-28)**

The Piney Woods School has established a proven track record in agricultural practices and is continuing to march toward Science, Technology, Engineering and Math (STEM) practices. STEM is critically important to today's society. This conceptual camp will unveil agriculture and robotics practices and how they are operationally related.

### **To the Tee (Ages 12 - 15)**

This golf skills camp will offer an innovative approach to making education fun by challenging the mind, body and motivating campers to learn. Participants will build skills such as teamwork, leadership, and responsibility as they learn to work with others to achieve a common goal. The camp will provide physical activity, along with quality instruction. All skill levels are welcome.
